WEIGH-IN

• If you make a weight category change within the same registration period that you registered and paid it will be FREE. If you make a weight category change in a different registration period from when you initially registered and paid, you will be charged the difference.

E.g. Registered and paid during early bird you can change any time during this period for FREE. If you then change weight category during regular, you would be charged 50 USD (difference between regular and early registration fee).

If you need to make a weight change after registration is closed, you would be charged 100 USD onsite at weigh-in.



- A competitor's weight shall be measured the day prior to his/her competition day. All competitors must weigh-in during the designated times on the schedule.
 - A competitor's weight may be measured twice. If a contestant does not qualify the first time, one more official weigh-in is granted within the time limit. So as not to be disqualified during official weigh-in, a scale, the same as the official one, shall be provided at the convention center as a test scale.
 - Any irregular action by the competitor or coach during the weigh-in may result in disqualification from event participation.
 - Weigh in, for both male and female shall be taken in the official V-neck uniform, or, if a contestant wishes, weigh-in may be done in underpants for male and underpants and bra for female contestants.
- Under NO circumstances may an underage athlete weigh-in in the nudity.**

Children (Pre-cadet) divisions will weigh-in clothing or dobok ONLY. Athletes will be given 0.2kg cushion for clothing.

Cadet and junior contestants must be weighed with underwear(s) and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate.

RANDOM WEIGH-IN

Children (Pre-Cadets) Do NOT have to attend to the random weigh-in.

The random weight in Cadet and Junior athletes will be announced at **7:30am** in the holding area each day of competition. The number of athletes will be determined according to the latest WT Rules.

COMPETITION RULES

WT Competition Rules & Interpretation, in force as of June 1, 2022.

COMPETITION SYSTEM

Single elimination tournament system.

CONTEST TIME

Pre-Cadets divisions: 2 rounds of 90 seconds, 1-minute break per round.

Cadet divisions: Best of 3 rounds of 1.5 minutes, 1-minute break per round.

Junior divisions: Best of 3 rounds of 1.5 minutes, 1-minute break per round.

The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as he or she sees fit.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Each team/club can send as many athletes as they wish per weight category to compete in the WT President's Cup | Pan American Edition 2022 weight divisions.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Holder of a valid 2022 WT Global Athlete License.
2. Member of the team/club of a pertinent Member National Association, recognized by the Pan American Taekwondo Union or World Taekwondo.
3. Juniors : 1st Kup and above
Cadets : 1st Kup and above
4. An athlete in order to be eligible for participation must be born in:
Juniors : 2005, 2006 or 2007
Cadets : 2008, 2009 or 2010



All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identificationcard at the official weigh-in. For those athletes that are not adults, a written consent must be submitted (please find enclosed on the last pages) at the registration, signed by one of the parents or legal guardians, accepting their participation and all parts of the official invitation.

*Juniors born in 2005 can compete as a junior or as a senior.
Competing in both categories is not allowed.*

COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Minimum age of 18 years.
2. WT Coach Certificate Level I or above is required.
3. Holder of a valid 2022 WT Global Official License.
Coaches who fail to provide proof of current WT Coach Certificate will not be allowed to coach at this event.
4. Coach is not allowed wearing Dobok.
5. 1 coach per 5 athletes is allowed. Exceeding this ratio is subject to an extra fee.

PROOF OF PAYMENT REQUIREMENT

Athlete sport entries may be deleted if no payment has been received. Each team shall inform PATU and USAT of their entry fee payment by submitting the transfer slip before the registration and payment deadline.

Athletes that are registered and not participating shall be deleted from the system BEFORE the registration deadline. If they are not deleted from the system they are considered as participating athletes and their entry fee shall be paid in full, even if they do not show up at the event.

NO REFUND

Pan American Taekwondo Union, USA Taekwondo and/or the Local Organizing Committee do not refund entry fees paid.

ACCREDITATION CARD DISTRIBUTION

Registered teams only receive the athlete and official's accreditation cards if all financial obligations have been fulfilled. For all registered athletes, the entry fee must be paid before the accreditation cards will be distributed to the respective team.

VISA REQUEST

The visa invitation letter per individual will be automatically generated from WT GMS platform if the visa is requested during the registration for the event. All members who need entry visa to USA must FIRST be registered for the event in GMS. You must then use this letter to apply for your or your team member's visa.

The WT Medical Code, WT mouthguard, bracing, taping, padding, and piercing rules are applicable, which all MNA participating this event must comply.



Applicable doping rules

The WT Anti-Doping Rules and the WADA Anti-Doping Code are applicable. Compulsory random doping tests will be conducted among all athletes. World Taekwondo and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the event.

Therapeutic Use Exemption

Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the “Prohibited List” of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and WADA Anti-Doping Code for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form (found on <https://ita.sport/TUE>), and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport. Report TUE applications also to the WT Sport Department via antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org by no later than 15 January 2022.

It is the responsibility of each registered team to ensure and guarantee that sufficient insurance coverage has been arranged for all athletes, team officials and other participants. Without sufficient insurance coverage, teams will not be allowed to compete.

Please fill out the Personal Indemnity Forms and return them to the Organization Committee before the deadline. Each participant (athletes, team officials, etc.) must fill out the indemnification form.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

All participating athletes, coaches, team officials, technical officials and participants at PATU events shall have mandatorily an international medical insurance that covers medical care (COVID included) and in case of emergency, repatriation to the country of origin, valid on the days present in the host country of the event. PATU, USAT nor the Local Organizing Committee shall be responsible to cover any medical costs incurred for medical treatment before, on or during the competition or repatriation in the broadest sense of the word.

All relevant documents proving that such an insurance is present, including insurance policy papers, should be taken to the event in case a medical situation occurs.

Each MNA/Club, Team doctor or team medical staff must ensure their athletes and team officials have valid international health insurance that covers medical and emergency care at the designated hospitals in Jacksonville before arrival to the venue.
