



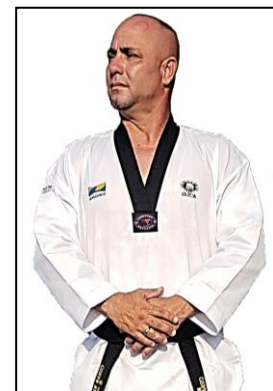

(€) or American dollars, USD, however, if you do not pay
online and pay on site, in cash, an additional surcharge of
10% of the total amount to be paid will be charged

GENERAL PROVISIONS:

This is a World Taekwondo, Level G1 Kyorugi, Team Kyorugi
3, & G1 Poomsae event.

COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY AND FEES (in USD):

All participants must meet the following requirements in order
to participate. This is an "Open" event, open for ages and
regardless of belt level, over 12 years old and up to 30, (in the
case of poomsae modality, KYORUGI IS OPEN FOR MORE
THAN 30 YEARS). (Cadet, Junior and Senior Categories).
Everyone must have a Global Athlete License (GAL) to
register. (Those who do not have it may register for the Festival
that will take place after G1)

- All athletes must have a passport or birth certificate from the
country they will represent.

- Competitors will compete at the age based on their year of
birth.

- Early Registration Fee (ends August 28, 2023):

\$100.00 for the first event. Extra\$50 for each additional event,
applicable to poomsae.

-Regular Registration Fee (ends September 15, 2023):

\$125.00 for the first event. Extra\$65 for each additional event,
applicable to poomsae.

- Late Registration Fee (ends September 25, 2023):

\$150.00 for the first event.\$Additional 80 for each additional
event, applicable to poomsae.

COACH ELIGIBILITY AND FEES (in EUR):

- All Coaches must be at least 18 years old, current Global
Official License (GOL) and Permit and qualification of World
Taekwondo Coach, (LEVEL 1)

- Coaches who do not provide Certificate as proof of current
WT Coach will not be allowed to enter this event.

If you register and pay for a division in the early/regular period and then add a new division in the regular or late registration period, you will be charged the difference between two registration periods for your first division and pay the respective fees for the period registered for their 2nd division. For example: if you register during the early registration period and paid USD\$100 and then add an additional division during the final registration date period (Sep 16-25, 2023), you will be charged USD\$150 for the addition you have made and you will pay USD\$75 for the difference of the registration fee of the early registration to the final registration fee for the first division.

REGISTRATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE NO EXCEPTIONS

CHANGES AND RATES (in USD):

All change requests made after September 25, 2023, including name change, event change, etc. will result in an administrative fee of USD\$50 per change request.

Weight changes after September 25, 2023 will be subject to a USD weight change fee.\$100 no exceptions.

- Changes before September 25, 2023: WT Simply Compete Login

- Changes after September 25, 2023 must be submitted with proper request in Change Form (see page 12) and USD change fee\$100 on the site between October 1 and 4, 2023.

- If you make a weight category change within the same registration period that you registered and paid for, it will be FREE.

- If you make a weight category change in a different registration period from when you initially registered and paid, you will be charged the difference. Registered and paid during early booking (until August 28, 2023) you can change at any time during this period for FREE. If you then change weight classes during the regular period (August 29 – September 14) you will be charged the difference between the regular and early registration fee. If you change weight classes during the late registration period (September 16-25) you will be charged the difference between the late and early registration fee.

- WT Recognized Poomsae Competition (Individual, Sex Couples and Mixed Couples, Mixed Team)

- WT Freestyle Poomsae Competition (Individual, Sex Pairs and Mixed Pairs, Mixed Team)

- Olympic style Kyorugi competition.

Team Kyorugi 3. Only genders, Mixed is not allowed.

DRAW OF COMPETITORS:

All athletes will be seeded according to the WT World Ranking of September 20, 2023. A minimum of 25% seeding will be done for all divisions in accordance with the WT ranking charter. The draws will be available one (1) day before the start of the competition of the respective weight category.

COMPETITION RULES:

The current WT Kyorugi and Poomsae competition rules will govern the 2023 Havana Open.

ENTRY RATES, TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

-All Registrations for Athletes, Coaches and Officials must be completed through the World Taekwondo Event Registration System:<https://woorldtkd.simplycompete.com>

- All athletes, coaches and officials must have a 2023 approved global license, (GAL or GOL) before registering.

- Round trip air tickets, ground transportation and room and board expenses will be borne by all participants.

World Taekwondo and the Pan American Taekwondo Union have established a NO REFUND policy.

- NO REFUNDS will be given for any reason after registration is complete.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT PROCESS:

Athletes, coaches and team officials must register for the event via worldtkd.simplycompete.com.

Pay online during WT Simply Compete registration.

GMS accepts credit card payments ONLY. All online payments are subject to a mandatory credit card processing fee based on total event registration due. Registration will not be confirmed until payment is received.

DO NOT wait until the last minute to register and pay.

Failure to submit payment by the early or early registration deadline will result in late fees with no exceptions.

Payments made on-site after the WT Simply Compete late registration deadline will not be subject to surcharges or modifications, except for the 10% on-site payment.

ANTI-DOPING REGULATIONS:

The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and when necessary, the World Anti-Doping Agency Code, shall apply throughout the Competition.

Mandatory drug testing will be conducted for all finalists, while random testing will be conducted among the quarterfinalists and semifinalists who failed to advance to the (semifinal). The WT and/or the AMA may randomly conduct competition tests prior to the PR Open. All contestants are required to submit their most recent and accurate athlete location (Whereabouts Info) to WADA.

TUE (Therapeutic Use that take any listed substance or medicine): In the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes, they are requested to visit the WADA website and file your TUE applications online at ADAMS

INDEMNITIES:

Participants without proper and valid Entry Entry Forms for health insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete in the Open. Liability waivers must be signed by participants or by the parent or legal guardian for athletes under 18 years of age prior to badge release at check-in. Photo ID is required to collect badges during check-in and weigh-in.

WT INTERNATIONAL RESERVATIONS:

- The organizer will request the required number of WT Internationals Referees.
- Umpires who are interested in officiating for this event must apply their registration through www.tkdreferee.com.
- The round trip airfare will be the responsibility of each International Referee.
- The Organizing Committee will cover four (4) nights of accommodation and living expenses (check-in early in the afternoon of October 3, 2023 and until the 5th of the aforementioned month and year; check-in before noon, check-out at noon on the appointed day).
- Please note: the referees meeting will take place from 6 to 8pm that same day at the event venue.
- The Organizing Committee will provide each participant WT International Referee with a per diem of USD\$150.00 per day during 4 days of competition.

NATIONAL REFEREES:

The Cuban Taekwondo Federation will designate 20 National Referees.

The Organizing Committee must provide the payment to each participating National Referee according to what is legislated in Cuba for this type of event in national currency.

Kyorugi Rules and Competition Format

The organizing committee has the right to change, modify the duration of the rounds, divisions and make official decisions without prior notice.

TEAM LEADER / TECHNICAL MEETING:

The PATU technical officials and the WT Technical Delegate will hold the Team Leaders meeting on Thursday, October 03, 2023, the meeting place will be announced one week before the event date.

The Technical Delegate and the WT Organizing Committee have the right to change, modify the duration of the rounds and combine divisions at the Team Leaders meeting. The official draw will be done automatically and published on the official PATU website.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS:

All combat athletes must wear a WT approved black V-neck, uniform (dobok) in good condition. Patches, embroidery, logos, team names, country names, athlete names, and stripes are permitted on uniforms.

NOTAPE IS ALLOWED ON ANY PART OF THE UNIFORM.

COACHES DRESS:

All coaches must be required to wear business suits (tie optional) for the semifinal and final rounds. Coaches who do not follow these rules will not be allowed to enter the field during finals and semifinals.

COMBAT TEAM:

The organizer will use the DAEDO Generation 2 PSS&E header, system for G2 combat divisions ONLY. Daedo Generation 2. Competitors are REQUIRED to purchase and use their own Daedo sensor socks and heels for combat events.

Daedo

Sensor socks and heels can be purchased by visiting the Daedo sales booth at the event. **(This management is still carried out, so it is safer to attend the Havana Open G1 with full equipment)**

All sparring competitors are responsible for providing their own gloves, forearms, shin guards, English guards or cups, and mouth guards.

No prescription or non-prescription glasses or goggles are allowed, no exceptions.

BRANDS:

All contestants must wear WT recognized doboks as well as protective equipment. The latest version of recognized WT, such a list of manufacturers is available on the World Taekwondo website.

WEIGHING:

The weigh-in of athletes over 12 years of age will take place in a designated weigh-in area one (1) day before the start of the respective weight category of the competition.

PLEASE GO TO

PROGRAM OF EVENTS FOR WEIGHING IN TIME / DATE.

- All weigh-in athletes must present their passport or national identification in the case of Cubans, issued by their respective governments.

- At weigh-in, male athletes (except adults) must wear a minimum of undergarments and female athletes (except adults) must wear a minimum of women's undergarments, which includes bras. In no way can a young, cadet or junior athlete weigh himself naked.

A tolerance allowance of 100 grams will be made for this concept.

- Each athlete will have one (1) attempt to pass the weigh-in.

However, one (1) extra attempt is allowed for those athletes who did not qualify the first time. This additional attempt must be made within the time limit of the official weigh-in hours on the same day.

- If an athlete wishes to change weight at the time of registration, he/she may do so for a fee of USD \$100.00. A test scale will be available outside the weigh rooms.

RANDOM WEIGHING:

All Kyorugi competitors are subject to this new WT rule. This random weigh-in must be completed 1 hour prior to the start of each competition day.

Poomsae Rules and Competition Format

The organizing committee has the right to change, modify and make official decisions without prior notice.

TEAM LEADER / TECHNICAL MEETING:

The PATU technical officials and the WT Technical Delegate will hold the Team Leaders meeting on October 3, 2023, the place of the meeting will be announced one week before the event date.

The designated Poomsae will be raffled at the Meeting on that day, October 3, 2023.

The chosen Poomsae will be published on the PATU official website after midnight on October 03, 2023.

The Technical Delegate and the WT Organizing Committee have the right to change, modify the competition format and combine divisions at the Team Leaders meeting.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS:

WT approved Y-neck Poomsae uniforms are mandatory for all competitors in all Poomsae divisions. Cadets and Juniors are allowed to wear Poom or Black Belt with Poomsae uniforms.

Poomsae competitors under 14 years of age must wear Poom Collar, Y-neck Uniforms.

COACHES DRESS:

All coaches must wear business suits (tie optional) for the semifinals and final rounds, those who do not comply with this requirement will not be allowed on the court during the finals and semifinals.

FREESTYLE POOMSAE:

The competition will start from the Final Round, and the top four individual competitors/pairs/teams will be awarded 1st, 2nd and two (2) 3rd places based on their total points in the final round.

In the event of a tie, the competitor with the highest technical score wins.

Places 3 and 4 are awarded with bronze medals.

*Competitors may use the same music and routine in the same division.

COMPETITION AND CLASSIFICATION RULES:

The latest WT Poomsae competition rules.

The ranking statutes will govern the 2023 Havana Open.

POOMSAE:

Simple Cut and Eliminate System:

Single Elimination will be used for all entered competitors.

Poomsae Divisions (U30). The cutting system will apply to all remaining Poomsae competitions.

CUTTING SYSTEM:

Preliminaries: When 20 or more competitors are participating;

The competition will start from the preliminary round with division of groups in different rings. Competitors will perform one (1) mandatory Designated Poomsae, and half of each group shall advance to the Semi-Final based on the highest scores in the preliminary round, each group may be judged by a different set of judges. If the number of competitors is odd, the number of competitors will be rounded up to an even number. Ex) If there are 23 competitors in the division, it will be considered as 24 competitors and 12 will advance to the semifinal.

Semifinal Selection: When 9 to 19 competitors participate;

The competition will start from the Semifinal round. Competitors will perform one (1) designated compulsory Poomsae, and 8 of them will advance to the final round based on the highest scores achieved by them.

Final: When 8 or less competitors participate, the competition will start from the Final Round. Competitors will perform two (2) compulsory Designated Poomsae, and the top four individual/pairs/team competitors will receive prizes based on their point total in the final round. In the event of a tie, the competitor with the highest performance points wins. 3rd and 4th place are awarded bronze medals.

Partner invitation function for Poomsae event:

WT GMS has implemented a feature for an individual member to invite partners for Pairs and Poomsae Teams. During registration for a Poomsae event, there is a new button called "Invite/Add". Your partner will receive an email about the invitation, then you must accept the invitation by registering through GMS in Havana Open G1.
