SEEDING

Seniors: All athletes will be seeded with a 25% minimum according to the latest available WT World Ranking.

TECHNICAL MEETING

The technical meeting at the Pan American Taekwondo Championships will take place on May 2 at the Convention Center of the Barceló Bávaro Hotel. The exact time and place are included in the program.

COMPETITION RULES

Current WT Competition Rules and Interpretation.

COMPETITION SYSTEM

Single Elimination.

DURATION OF THE BOUTS

3 rounds of 2 minutes, minute 1 rest between each round.

The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the time of the rounds as he sees fit.

TEAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Each National Team may send one (1) male and one (1) female athlete per weight category to compete in the Pan American Taekwondo Championships 2022.

The maximum number of competitors per MNA is sixteen (16), plus Wild Card invitation holders. No more than 2 athletes for each weight category per MNA, including Wild Card invitation holders.

ATHLETES ELIGIBILITY

1. Holder of a valid 2022 WT Global Athlete License.
2. Member of the national team of a national sports association, recognized by the Panamerican Taekwondo Union or World Taekwondo.
3. Holder of the nationality of the corresponding National Sports Association.
4. An athlete to be eligible to participate must be born on or 2005 before. All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport at the official weigh-in.

COACH ELIGIBILITY

1. Minimum age of 18 years old.
2. Holder of the WT Level II Coach Certification (awarded by the WT).
3. Holder of a valid 2022 WT Global License.

MEDICAL STAFF ELIGIBILITY

4. Minimum age of 18 years old.
5. Medical License Holder.
6. Holder of a valid 2022 WT Global License.

REFEREES

PATU shall determine the number of appointed international referees, and the PATU Referee Committee shall notify their selection.

- The cost of the round trip must be covered by each participating international referee.
- All International Referees must present a negative PCR test for the SARS-COV-2 virus within 72 hours of arrival at the host hotel.
- Referees must follow all COVID protocols described in the event outline.
- Referees must provide their own travel medical insurance including COVID coverage.
- The OC is responsible for arranging and providing transportation to and from the airport and the hotel/location.
- The Organizing Committee will cover FIVE (5) nights of accommodation and board, arriving on Monday, May 1st and departing on Sunday, 6 May 2022.
- The Organizing Committee will provide each International Referee with a daily per diem of USD\$100 per day of competition.

The referee meeting will be held in accordance with the PATU program.

For entering the Field of Play the necessary implements for COVID-19 protocols will be provided.

FIELD OF PLAY REGULATIONS

By accepting an accreditation credential, all registered persons agree to comply with the rules of the competition area and the sanitary protocols applicable to this event.

MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING

Accreditation of medical personnel

All medical personnel of the respective teams must apply for the accreditation credential.

Applicable doping rules

WT Anti-Doping Rules and the WADA Anti-Doping Code apply. Mandatory random doping tests will be conducted among all athletes.

INDEMNITIES

It is the responsibility of each registered team to ensure their athletes and team officials have correctly completed the indemnity and commitment forms and have duly signed them, thereby releasing WT, PATU, the Organizing Committee and all other officials and athletes from any claims for injuries or losses arising in the course of participation in the 2022 Pan American Taekwondo Championships or any activity related thereto.

ACCOMODATION

Hotel accommodations

As the format of the event will be a biosafety bubble, all accredited national teams participating in the event must book their hotel accommodation through the travel agency designated for this purpose. HEALTH INSURANCE

All participating athletes, coaches, team officials, technical officials, and participants in PATU events must have medical insurance covering medical care (COVID-19 included) and in case of emergency, repatriation to the country of origin, valid on the days present in the host country of the event.

It is the responsibility of each registered team to ensure and guarantee that insurance coverage is sufficient for all athletes, team officials and other participants.

COVID-19 TEST

In the event that a team representative or official must undergo a PCR test at any time during the competition or prior to departure, the OC may arrange for testing within hours 72.

TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT shall appoint one (1) Technical Delegate and four (4) CSB members.
The following conditions shall apply:

- The Organizing Committee will cover five nights of accommodation and board, arriving on Sunday, May 1 and departing on Friday, 6 May 1. 2022.
- The Organizing Committee will provide the Technical Delegate with a daily per diem of \$200 per day of competition.
- The Organizing Committee will provide the CSB members with a daily per diem of USD\$100 per day of competition.
- They must present a negative PCR test for the SARS-COV-2 virus within hours 72 of arrival at the host hotel.
- They must follow all COVID protocols described in the event outline.

Protocol by COVID-19

ACCREDITATION GUIDELINES

The Dominican Taekwondo Federation acts in accordance with local laws and regulations and follows the recommendations of government public health services to minimize COVID-19 risk. Continuous risk assessments and monitoring of the situation and its changes at the national level, and especially at the local level, will ensure valid compliance with recommended and mandatory health and safety standards and measures.

The legal aspects related to the organization of the competition during the pandemic have been taken into account and are made public to the athletes, representatives and accompanying persons of the competitors and all those involved in the organization.

Accreditations will be made in the following steps 3:

Step 1: PCR test 72 hours prior to departure to the Pan American venue for all event attendees. Send the tests of the complete team in a file to coviddominicanevents@gmail.com and bring them in original.

Step 2: The Covid-19 rapid test will be administered to each team member upon arrival at the hotel. Only members with a negative test result will be allowed to stay at the hotel and obtain accreditation. For any reason for which you leave the hotel, you must submit to a test to reenter after a negative test result.

Step 3: After the results of the test, the hotel check-in will be done at the accommodation desk, this will be done only by a team representative.

Step 4: After the accommodation desk, the team representative will make the reservation for accreditation. Only team representatives will be allowed to enter the accreditation room.

For international flights, some passengers may be required to submit a PCR test. If you wish, you can have your equipment tested at the hotel. The cost of the test will be paid in cash. Those wishing to take a PCR test should inform the organizing committee when checking in their teams.

If any person presents symptoms of SARS-CoV2, he/she will be provided with the assistance regulated by the Ministry of Public Health.

All participants in the event must wear masks at all times.

This regulation is designed and binding on all participants of the event who accept the instructions indicated when they receive their official accreditation.

Audience. Spectators will not be allowed into the competition areas.

COMPETITION AREA (HALL)

It is mandatory to wear masks, disinfect hands and check body temperature before entering the Competition Hall.

Competitors / Participants

COVID TESTING. Due to the current situation in America, and in order to protect all our participants and the safe implementation of the competition, we ask EVERYONE to have a negative PCR test upon arrival no later than 72 hours.

The use of a mask is mandatory at all times, except in the following situations:

- During a meal at the hotel

Weigh-in

All participants attending the official weigh-in must disinfect their hands and wear a mask before entering the room. Referees must wear protective gloves along with the mask.

Accreditation

Accreditation and registration will be conducted on a scheduled appointment basis. Follow the link mentioned in this call to book your appointments.

Competition Area

Access to the competition area is only permitted on the day of the athlete's competition. Competitors will remain during the competition in their rooms or in the designated waiting area. When each individual competitor's category begins, the competitors will go to the warm-up area accompanied by their coach, in that area they will get electronic equipment.

The use of sanitary facilities will be allowed ONLY within the competition area.

At the medal ceremony, athletes and medal presenters must wear masks.

The ceremony will be conducted without a handshake.

Referees / Delegates / Organizers / Technical Staff

Are considered to be all those who are located within the field of play. Referees, delegates, organizers and technical staff should also be restricted in their movement in the room, avoid approaching competitors whenever possible and have a chosen place to stand and sit.

The tatami should be cleaned and sprayed with disinfectant on a regular basis. Equipment (headgear and chess protector) should also be sprayed with disinfectant after each fight.

People in charge of picking up, transporting, and returning the equipment should wash their hands, use disinfectant, or use disposable gloves, and discard them after handling the equipment.

Central referees must wear face masks.

Medical procedures / Warm-up sites

Everyone should be considered potentially contagious; therefore, athletes and medical personnel should wear protective equipment at all times. A hand washing and disinfection protocol will be implemented when entering and leaving these rooms and between each intervention by medical personnel.

Volunteers

Volunteers must adhere to measures to prevent the spread of infection in all locations where they are deployed. The use of a protective mask covering the mouth and nose and frequent hand disinfection are mandatory. Used gloves and masks should only be stored in specially designed containers. Disinfection of tatamis and equipment is carried out in a way that does not disturb the athletes and does not reach their immediate vicinity. It is not allowed to enter the athlete's movement zone.

Audience / Viewers

Public / spectators will be allowed during the competition. Entry fee: USD\$10.00 per person.

VIPs

VIP guests must wear face masks and use hand sanitizer when entering the lounge. They must be seated in a pre-assigned seat.
