DOBOK REQUIEMENTS

WT POOMSAE GUIDELINES WILL BE FOLLOWED

Youth Divisions (Ages 8-9 and 10-11): May wear same dobok as the cadets or a Black V-Neck.

Must wear a poom belt (red/black) - Solid black belt not allowed.

<u>Cadet Division (Ages 12-14)</u>: White top with red and black collar, plus blue pants for males and red pants for females.

Must wear a poom belt (red/black) - Solid black belt not allowed.



<u>Junior & Senior Divisions (Ages 15-50)</u>: White top with dark blue pants for males and light blue pants for females.



Master Divisions (Ages 51 & up): Yellow top and dark blue pants for both males and females.



Anything not following the WT guideline will result in a **0.6 deduction** from the final score.



COMPETITION METHOD & DESIGNATED POOMSAE

COMPETITION METHOD:

- All divisions will be using Cut Off format.
 - Athletes will perform 1 poomsae for the Preliminary (20+)
 - Athletes will perform 2 poomsae in the Semi (9-19) and Final Round (1-8)

DESIGNATED POOMSAE AND ORDER OF COMPETITION:

• Will be drawn live on FEBRUARY 20, 2022, at head of team meeting.

AWARDS:

- The top 4 athletes of each division (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 3rd) will receive a digital award certificate
- This certificate will be sent by email

All PATU Black Belt Athletes

RECORDING REQUIREMENTS

- The performances may be video recorded indoors or outdoors. Please ensure you follow the
 instructions of your local and national health authorities with regard to physical distancing
 and outdoor excursions.
- The athlete's entire body must be in frame during the video recording at all times. Any time
 a portion of the athlete's body leaves the frame will result in a deduction. Please refer to the
 scoring rules for details.
- Videos must be submitted in their raw format. No editing permitted. Do not include any annotations such as athlete's name and/or NOC in the video.
- No music except for Free Style Divisions. Music to be used in Free Style performance must be without lyrics.
- The video recording must be done with the athlete facing the camera when in the start position. The camera must be stationary but may be rotated left & right from its starting point. Zooming in and out during performance is not permitted.





Note: Freestyle recordings may rotate the camera further if needed to keep the athlete in frame.

Video recording submissions must be of sufficient quality to enable referees to effectively
judge all movements. It is recommended that you use the following recording details for
best results:

- Resolution: 1080p minimum

- Frame Rate: 60fps minimum

- Orientation: Horizontal (Landscape)

• If your video is not clear enough for the referees, this may affect your overall score.

- Only IOC recognized flags are permitted to be displayed. Religious or political displays are NOT permitted.
- After the Head of Team meeting. The online systems company Vaztic will email all competitors a unique link to submit their videos for the competition. This link will open a page showing the athlete's name, NOC (National Olympic Committee), and division. The page will contain one submission box for each required video and will be labeled with the round and the poomsae required for the video. Please be sure to upload the correct poomsae in the correct order. The page will display a confirmation message after each successfully uploaded video.
- All commands are encouraged (but not mandatory) to be given and audible on the video.

ONLINE POOMSAE RULES

- Video editing of any sort will result in disqualification.
- If an incorrect uniform is worn for the division, this will result in a 0.6 deduction from the final score.
- Athletes cannot perform the freestyle poomsae division on spring loaded floors/mats.
 Using spring loaded floors/mats in the freestyle divisions will result in disqualification.
- Shoes being worn during the competition will result in disqualification.
- Socks, jewelry, taping or bracing will result in a **0.6 point** deduction.
- If any part of the athlete's body is cut-off by the video frame a **0.3 point** deduction will apply for each Poom movement. If the whole body is cut-off by the video frame a **0.6 point** deduction will apply for each Poom movement.
- If there is any interference (moving person, animal, etc.) on the field of play, there will be a
 0.3 point deduction.
- Videos labeled wrong or uploaded in the incorrect order will result in the referees awarding
 0.0 Accuracy and 1.5 Presentation for each incorrect poomsae.
- Videos containing political, social, or religious propaganda will result in disqualification.
- Videos containing profanity or indecent images, or gestures will result in disqualification.





- Athletes who submit videos after the submission deadline will be **disqualified.**
- Contestants who submitted videos used in other competitions will be disqualified.
- Non-Freestyle videos containing music shall result in a **0.6 point** deduction.

FREESTYLE GUIDELINES

COMPETITION METHOD:

- Divisions:
 - Individual Male & Female
 - Ages 12-17 and 18 Years & Over
 - Pair (One Female/One Male)
 - Ages 12-17 and 18 Years & Over
 - Team (mixed)
 - Ages 12 & above
 - 5 (3 male/2 female or 3 female/2 male)

All competitors will compete in 1 final round no matter how many competitors in a division
