6. QUALIFICATIONS:

In accordance with Article 4: Qualification of Contestant of the WT Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

- Criterion 1: Holder of the nationality of the participating team.
- Criterion 2: An athlete must be nominated by an MNA recognized by the WT.
- Criterion 3: Holder of Black Belt Taekwondo Dan.
- Criterion 4: Holder of the WT Global Athlete License (GAL) 2023
- Criterion 5: An athlete must be at least 15 years old. Born between 2008.

7. COMPETITION RULES WT:

The latest published PATU Team and WT Competition Rules and Interpretation. Pan American Games rules will be used.

9. METHOD OF COMPETITION

Team Kyorugui

- Round Robin and Single Elimination system
- Ranking following 2023 Pan Am Series II Brazil results.
- Each MNA can register ONE team per competition type:
 - Of 3 athletes, and 1 alternate same gender SENIOR (male/female).
 - Of 3 athletes, and 1 alternate same gender JUNIOR (male/female).
 - Of 4 athletes, and 1 alternate mixed SENIOR (total 2 females and 2 males).
- Athletes in Team Kyorugui must be different from those participating individually.
- Max of 3 teams will be seeded in Team Kyorugui groups, and brackets will be randomly drawn at the Technical Meeting.

10. CONTEST TIME

Team Kyorugui

Best of 3 system SENIOR & JUNIOR (3 minutes of 1st round, 2 minutes of 2nd and 3rd rounds x 1 minute break) – Same Gender

Best of 3 system MIXED

(4 minutes of 1st round, 2 minutes of 2nd and 3rd rounds x 1 minute break) – Mixed

12. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS

i. Round-trip Airfare and Accommodation.

Round trip airfare and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating Member National Association. Accommodation in the official hotels is mandatory there will be no transportation service as the venue is walking distance. The OC will not be responsible for any inconvenience outside the official Hotels.

13. WT GLOBAL LICENSE AND ONLINE REGISTRATION.

- i. WT Global License Registration. All athletes and team officials must first be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) OR Global Official License (GOL) (Level I).
- ii. WT Online Registration. (Simply Compete)

National team entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system, and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. National Team GMS admins will be notified via email once online registration is open. All Athletes and officials must be registered under the team's name Country Name National Team.

Once an MNA registers online through GMS, registration cannot be changed after April 13th, 11:59 pm Santo Domingo Local Time.

14. ENTRY FEES:

i. The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the Organizing Committee **in cash in US\$ only** at the Registration Center in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, before the start of the competition. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successfully paying the entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

- ii. The credential collection will be held at the Olympic Center from April 21-23, 2023.

15. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

The PATU will appoint a total of 17 International Referees, including the PATU Referee Chairman. The appointed international referees shall officiate at the Pan American Teams Championships; the following conditions shall apply:

- a. International Referees are required to pay for their round-trip airfares.
- b. The Organizing Committee shall cover the expenses for 2 (TWO) nights' stay of room and board. Check-in: April 27th, 2023 / check-out: April 29th, 2023.
- c. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$150 to the selected International Referees for the competition and training period (total of TWO days; US\$300 per referee, training day, and competition).





16. TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT/PATU will appoint one (1) Technical Delegate and up to five (5) members of the Competition Supervisory Board. The following conditions shall apply:

The Organizing Committee shall provide accommodation and board and cover a per diem of US\$200 to the Technical Delegate for 2 days and the CSB members US\$150 for the competition period (total of two days; US\$300 per person).

17. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO UNIFORM (DOBOK) AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- A. DAEDO Gen2 Protector and Scoring System (PSS), including PSS Headgear, will be used for the competition.
- B. All participating teams are required to have blue and red uniforms. White dobok can be used two in case the uniform stock is low. Don't hesitate to get in touch with info@daedo.com for shipping and stock information.
- C. Participating contestants must wear WT/PATU-recognized COLOR doboks and WT-PATUrecognized protective equipment. The latest version of the WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available on the website of WT (<u>http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtf-partners/recognized</u>).
- D. The Organizing Committee will provide the participating contestants' Protector and Scoring System (PSS). Participating contestants must bring their groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks, and shin and forearm guards for personal use.

Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for the inspection of their doboks and protective equipment. Any contestant who wears unofficial doboks or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete. Instant Video Replay (IVR) System will be used.

18. IDENTIFICATION OF NOC CODE AND MANUFACTURER

The national flag shall be located between 3 to 3.5cm below the shoulder line of the right arm.

I. NOC Code is a three-letter National Olympic Committee abbreviation, and it shall be **printed at the back in black** and centered at 5cm or higher from the bottom line of the upper garment within the size of 30cm width x 12cm height. The font of the letters shall be in bold "Verdana". Manufacturer's identifications (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be located one for the top of Kyorugui dobok within 30cm2 and between 3 to 3.5cm below the shoulder line of the left arm, one for bottoms of Kyorugui dobok within 30cm2 located above the knee and center of the right leg, and one for Kyorugui belt within 6cm2 at the end of the belt. For Poomsae doboks the NOC code will be allocated on the back.





19. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING

i. The head of team meeting shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the competition on **April 27th**, **2023 at 18:00 hrs** more details to be released soon.

20. WEIGH-IN

- i. The general weigh-in of the contestants shall be completed one day before their scheduled competition day on **April 27th**, **2023**.
- ii. Junior contestants must be weighed with underwear(s), and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate.
- iii. During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants, and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. NO weigh-in in NUDITY IS ALLOW FOR UNDERAGED ATHLETES by no means.

21. INDEMNITIES

- i. The respective national taekwondo associations shall ensure that all officials and participants are covered with effective travel & medical insurance coverage.
- ii. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the competition.
- iii. The Organizing Committee will acquire Public Liability event insurance.
- iv. All participants must sign the responsibility waiver at the time of registration.

22. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION

The participating teams are required to submit the hotel reservation only via the official hotels through PATU website and Dominican Travel Agency by no later than April 20th, 2023. No other registration method will be accepted.

Cancellations must be made in writing.

Please note that cancellations received after April 21st, 2023 are strictly non-refundable. Bookings made after this date are subject to availability. The initial minimum payment will be required at the time of booking; full cancellation policy will be in place once the booking is confirmed.

23. VISA INFORMATION

The visa recommendation letters will be generated from Dominican Taekwondo Federation and PATU The deadline for a visa request is April 15th, 2023. Please send an email to wtdominicana@gmail.com or events@panamericantaekwondounion.org





24. COACH's ATTIRE

Coaches must wear formal suits such as ties, jackets, dress shirts (long or short), and trousers during the event. If any coach refuses to wear the abovementioned attire, he or she will not be allowed to access the field of play for the 2023 Pan American Teams Championships.

25. RANKING

The 2023 Pan American Championships will be ranked as P8 in the Panamerican Ranking for Teams Ranking purposes and for Pan American Games ranking seeding system.
