- CONTESTANTS -

WORLD TAEKWONDO (WT) GLOBAL LICENSE

- A World Taekwondo Global Licence is required by all athletes, coaches and officials participating in Canada Open 2024. World Taekwondo Global License registrations & renewals can only be made through the WT recognized Member National Associations and applications should be made at least 2 months before the tournament starts to ensure the WT Global License can be processed and approved in time. The WT Global License must be valid for 2024 or renewed to be used for 2024.
- The WT Global license is the responsibility of all participants (athletes, coaches and officials) participating at Canada Open 2024 and must be registered and approved through their respective WT Member National Association.
- **There will be NO World Taekwondo Global Licenses registration onsite**

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

- Must have a Kukkiwon Dan or Poom certificate
- Must have a valid 2024 World Taekwondo Global License with event pass
- Must be a member of the team/club of a pertinent Member National Association (MNA), recognized by World Taekwondo

All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identification card at accreditation pick up

COACH ELIGIBILITY

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Must have a valid 2024 World Taekwondo Global License with event pass
- Must have a World Taekwondo Coach License Level I Coach Certification or the respective CU Coach License (granted by participation in a WT recognized CU Coach Seminar)



















Any coach that cannot provide proof of a WT coach certification will not be allowed to coach at this event

- If you are coaching both Kyorugi and Poomsae, you will only need to register as a Kyorugi coach

Coach Dress Code and Regulations

- Athletic attire/team tracksuit or business attire
- Jeans and doboks are not permitted
- Closed footwear only; no heels or sandals
- No chewing gum or use of electronic devices, such as cell phones, PDA or video cameras
- Coaches perceived to be under the influence of alcohol/drugs will not be allowed in the competition area
- All coaches are required to wear a sport coat for the semi-final and final rounds
- Any type of cap/hat is not allowed

Competition Rules

- The latest published World Taekwondo Poomsae Competition Rules & Interpretation shall be applied
- Contestants may compete in a maximum of two events per WT Competition Rules (in recognized poomsae and/or freestyle poomsae)

Seeding

- World Taekwondo Poomsae World Ranking Bylaw will be applied
- Seeding will be done for Recognized Under 30, Recognized Under 40, and Over 17 Freestyle divisions
- All other poomsae divisions will not be seeded

Visa Information

- Participants are required to check Canada's entry visa application waiting times in their own countries and submit requests for recommendation letters through the online form if applicable
- The Organizing Committee cannot guarantee entry into Canada and can only offer assistance
- It is the responsibility of each participant to apply for and secure the correct entry visa for Canada if required
 - The visa application process should be started at least one week before the waiting time deadline in the participant's home country

- MEDICAL CONTROL -

ANTI-DOPING

- The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions
- Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests will be conducted to the rest of the athletes
- The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out of competition testing prior to this event

Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE)

- TUE Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact tue@ita.sport to have it set up.
- Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form at International Testing Agency Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) Application Form - International Testing Agency (ita.sport) and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport with copy to antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org by at least 30 days before the first competition day.
