






Requirements:

- 1. Be 18 years old or older.
- 2. Have Global Officer Licence WT 2024 (GOL).
- 3. All coaches must have the WT Coaches Certification Course Level 1.0

COACHES DRESS CODE

Formal with blazer(tie is not mandatory) or tracksuit semifinals & finals. Sports Jacket for all coaches during preliminaries

TECHNICAL RULES

All coaches must be in good standing with their MNA and the current holder of the World Taekwondo Federation and GAL Taekwondo License. Application deadlines and fees will be strictly adhered to and there will be no exceptions. Please see the Application Fees and Deadlines section of this package

REGISTRATION PROCESS & DEADLINES

All registrations must be made through the World Taekwondo (WT) GMS - online registration. All Athletes, Coaches and Officials must belong to an Association that is part of current World Taekwondo and have the World Taekwondo License to register.

Early registration begins: March 4, 2024 00:01 hrs (GMT -5)
Early registration deadline is: April 8, 2024 11:59 p.m. (GMT -5)
Regular registration has a deadline of: May 15, 2024 23:59 hrs (GMT -5)
Late registration has a deadline of: May 24, 2024 23:59 hrs (GMT -5)

Registration on site has a deadline of: May 29, 2024 before the technical meeting with a fee of \$200 for one event and \$300 for two events.

- All registration must be done through https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com/ (cadets, junior and senior)

Payment for the championship must be made only upon event accreditation in cash: May 29 at the Headquarters hotel (soon to be confirmed) from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

All fees must be paid in USD. If the online registered athlete is not participating in the competition, but has not been removed from the entry list by the deadline, his or her team or official must pay the full (100%) entry fee to participate.

Changes in weight divisions after the regular entry deadline will account for \$50.00 (before official weigh-in)

REFEREES

- The Pan American Taekwondo Union will designate the number of referees required.
- Each International Referee must cover their own airline tickets.
- 5 hotel nights and meals will be covered by the OC. (Check In: may 28, 2024 / Check Out: june 2 2024).
- The OC will pay a fee of 150 USD for each of the competition days.

RESPONSIBILITY

By registering for the Open Ecuador G2, all participants accept the rules and regulations of participation established by the organizing committee. All competitors participate at their own risk. The Organizer is not responsible for any loss or damage to athletes or equipment under any circumstances.

Disclaimers must be signed by participants (or parent or legal guardian of athletes under 18 years of age) prior to submitting credentials at check-in. You will not receive a credential without submitting a signed waiver.

DOCTOR

- The CO will only provide medical services in emergency situations where a participant is injured.
- Participants will be responsible for all expenses incurred as a result of injury and/or hospitalization.
- The CO recommends that the participant have health insurance and all documents at hand.

SAFETY

The organizing committee and the supervisor are not responsible for equipment, damages, violence, losses and injuries during your stay in ECUADOR.

First aid will be provided by the organization and should only be used in an emergency.

DOPING

The WT Anti-Doping Regulations and Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the World Anti-Doping Agency Code, will apply in all competitions.

Anti-doping tests may be carried out for all finalists as provided by World Taekwondo Anti-Doping, random tests will be carried out among the quarterfinalists and semi-finalists who did not advance to the (semi)final. The WT and/or WADA may conduct out-of-competition random checks prior to the tournament.

Therefore, all participating competitors must submit their most recent and accurate Athlete Location Forms (Location Information) to WT.

TUE (Therapeutic Use taking any listed substance or medication): In the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and the Anti-Doping Code of the World Anti-Doping "Anti-Doping Agency" (WADA) it is requested for therapeutic purposes, in case If you have any questions, visit the WADA website and submit your TUE applications with ADAMS online.

UNIFORM

Only WT approved uniforms will be allowed.

COMPETITION SYSTEM

Cadet, Junior and senior competitors will use the current WT rules. Best of 3 rounds, rules by february 2023.

WEIGHT IN

- If you make a weight category change within the same registration period you registered, it will be FREE.
- If you need to make a weight change after registration closes, you will be charged \$50 at the weighing site until de Technical Meeting, no weigh change Will be allowed after technical meeting.
- A competitor's weight must be measured the day before the day of the competition.
- All competitors must weigh-in during the times designated in the program. A competitor's weight can be
- · measure twice.
- If a competitor fails to qualify the first time, one more official weigh-in will be awarded within the time limit.
- Any irregular action by the competitor or coach during the weigh-in may result in disqualification of the athlete.
- participate in the event.
- Random weighing will be carried out according to the rules of the WT
- During weigh-in, the male competitor must wear underwear and the female competitor must wear underwear. However, the weigh-in can be done naked if the senior competitor so wishes.
- Cadet and Junior competitors must be weighed in their underwear and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate.

UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES CAN AN UNDERAGE ATHLETE BE WEIGHTED IN WITHOUT ANY CLOTHES ON

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the four (4) best athletes in their respective modalities and categories.

1st Place - Gold Medal, 2nd Place - Silver Medal and two (2) 3rd Place - Bronze Medals.

- The Open trophy for the MVP male and female athlete will be awarded with G-2 Kyorugui.
- An open 1st, 2nd and 3rd place trophy will be awarded to G-2 Kyorugui.
- The Open trophy for the best male and female trainer will be awarded with G-2 Kyorugui.
