1. Applicable Championships

5 Official events selected, promoted and organized by PATU obtaining an equal rank of points for the 5 P10 qualifying events. PATU reserves the rights and decision of the scoring events.

Panam Series V, Puerto Rico march, 2025






2. Categorías y divisiones.

2.1 Categories

The PATU Ranking will apply only to the categories that will include those born between 2004 and 2009.

2.2 Divisions

The divisions that are included in this ranking are mixed pair freestyle, recognized men's individual and recognized women's individual. Which, for this ranking to be valid, the same 2 athletes must mandatory participated in the three divisions mentioned above.





3. General Rules

- Rankig PANAM SERIES SUB 22 aims for a fair qualification for the Asuncion 2025 Junior
 Pan American Games, begins in Queretaro and has different rules than the PATU
 Ranking for kids, Cadet, Junior.
- The Ranked Poomsae Competition is a single category that is made up of Freestyle Pairs, and those same 2 athletes must do recognized individual poomsae. The counting of the points is the sum of the 3 competitions, these being mandatory for the 2 athletes.
- All competitors will earn points for participation, round won and position obtained.
- In order to obtain direct qualification by ranking points to the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games, it will be mandatory to participate in a minimum of 4 of the 5 events to obtain points.
- The qualifying events will be held in OPEN format with the respective authorization of the MNA/PATU
- In the event of a tie on points, the best result of the last event will prevail.
- Classification will be nominal and non-transferable.
- There will be no limit to the number of competitors registered per country
- Host country will be entitled to a place as long as they compete in 1 of 5 events.
- The ranking positions of the qualifying process will be taken into account for the seeding of the Junior Pan American Games.
- The host country will have its competitor seeded at number 4, if they not have a better position per ranking.
- This ranking is Unique, it applies only to the Qualification Process for the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games, at the end of this process, the Points are no longer valid.
- The máximum qualification quota is:

4. Classification Formula:

4.1 General Points Calculation Formula

Ranking Points= PF+IV+IF

PF: Points obtained for the freestyle pair modality.

IV: Points obtained for the recognized individual male modality.

IF: Points obtained for the women 's recognized individual modality

4.2 Calculation Formula per division

PF, IV, IF = PR + PP + PW

PR: Ranking points.

PP: P: Participation points.

PW: Points per won round.

4.3 Final Points

These are the points obtained in the 5 or 4 possible events to qualify for the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American G



5. Level

The degree of these Events will be as follows:

The events approved and recognized as ranking events will be published on the oficial PATU website.

The technical delegate will evaluate the event and present the official report to the Secretary General and the sports and events management department within ten (10) working days after the end of the championship.

The President of PATU will determine or may empower the Secretary General to determine the qualification after the evaluation and recommendation of the Technical Delegate and the report presented by the Organizing Committee.



6. Assigning Points

6.1 Assigning points by Rank (example)

Points will be awarded according to the position of the event rang held according to the following table:

6.2 General Rules

All competitors will be given 20 points just for participating and at least one round will need to be completed in order to be awarded the points per Rank in that championship

All will have their score with accordance to their position in accordance with the table in Article 6.1

For each match won they will get 10 extra points for the ranking of that championship, competitors who pass rounds without an opponent, are not counted as a won match.

6.3 Validity of Points

The points will be valid until the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games

The deduction will be made once the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games are over.

6.4 Application of Points

- The organizing committee will submit the tournament report (template provided by the OVR) to the PATU Secretariat within
- Ranking points will only be applied when the Technical Delegate approves the official results and sends the official results to the PATU no later than two (2) days after the end of the tournament.

6.5 Cancellation of Ranking Points

Sanctions are proposed by the Technical Director of the event in writing and approved by the PATU Ranking technical commission and will be for decisions made interpreting the WT regulations following its principles of fairness and equality.

If a competitor is sanctioned, he may lose the points and be penalized with the impossibility of attending any other event scoring for the ranking, depending on the decision of the Technical Commission based on the seriousness of the facts.

If a competitor is disqualified they will not get the participation ranking points for this event.

6.6 Tie-Breaking Criteria

Best position in a higher level event. EXAMPLE: There are 5 championships that give 100points to the first one (the 5 are of higher level), it will be obtained which of the competitors was in the best position in ANY of the 5 events. If a competitor was 1st in an event and the other obtained a 3rd position as the best position, the one who finished first on one of those championships will be better classified in the ranking.

If the two competitors have finished 1st in any of these championships /the tie persists), they will be the one with the best result in the last event of the ranking.

If the tie persists, the points will go for the competitor who has participated in the most championships.

If the tie persists: the technical commission will establish a solution for the tie-breaker



7. Update of Points

7.1 Ranking Update Rules


- The ranking will be updated once a month
- In the event that after the 5th there is a correction of a position in teh ranking of an ending month, it will not be shown until the next update.
- The Ranking will be updated at the end of the last scoring event even if the current month has no tended.

9. Competitor Seeding

9.1 Seeding

- The seeding of the competitors will be 100% in any case
- In the event that any of the seeded athletes are not eligible to participate (ex. Are not registered on the entry list or do not show up), the next highest ranked athlete(s) will be seeded, in the case of the first event all competitors will enter by random Position.

10. Amendment

These bylaws could be amendment from time to time, with PATU Council Approval.
