QUALIFICATIONS

In accordance with Article 4: Competitor Qualification of the WT Competition Rules, the competitor must:

Criterion 1: Be a Taekwondo Black Belt.

Criterion 2: WT 2025 Global Athlete License (GAL).

Criterion 3: All coaches must have WT Level 1 or level 2 certification.

Criterion 4 (Parataekwondo): Be 5-1 Geup or black belt.

Criterion 5 (Parataekwondo): The athlete must undergo an International Classification in accordance with the World Taekwondo Classification Rules and be assigned a Sport Class and Sport Class Status before the competition. Athletes who report Ineligible (NE) or have a Non-Complete Classification (CNC) will not be able to compete.

MEDICAL DIAGNOSTICS FORM THROUGH WORLD TAEKWONDO CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

Medical Diagnostic Form must be submitted for any NEW (N) or REVIEW (R) athletes registered for the tournament.

Deadline for uploading MDFs to the WTCS is on the registration deadline (20 April 2025). If no MDF has been submitted by the deadline, the athlete will not be called for classification and cannot compete.

The entry fee will not be refunded. Following IPC Guidelines on data protection concerning athletes and personal classification information, World Taekwondo has in connection with IPC created the World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS).

World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is the WT online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by the WT Classification Evaluation Committee to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC).

All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL). Fill out the form and submit the MNA Account Request form to the Para Taekwondo Department at para-tkd@worldtaekwondo.org.

Username and password will then be sent to the communicated email address. WTCS Account Policy – Each Member Federation must internally designate exactly one (1) primary user responsible for WTCS Account.

COMPETITION METHOD

Kirugui: Simple Elimination System, best of 3 rounds;

Parataekwondo: Simple Elimination System, best of 3 rounds;

Poomsae:

- Simple cut and elimination system;
- All Freestyle songs must be submitted before the technical congress;

Times can ONLY be adjusted by the WT TD (Technical Delegate)

RANKING

All athletes will be seeded according to the latest WT world ranking.

WILD CARD

The winners (first place only) of the senior category (Kyorugui & Poomsae) have a wild card for the 2026 Pan American Senior Championship.

INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

PATU will appoint a total of 30 International/Panamerican Referees, in addition to the PATU Referee Chairman. The designated international referees will act at Rio Open G2; The following conditions apply:

- International/Panamerican referees must pay their own round-trip airfare.
- The Organizing Committee will cover the living expenses of 5 nights of accommodation and food for the kyorugui, parataekwondo and poomsae competition. Arrival: 27/05/2025
Departure: 01/06/2025.
- The Organizing Committee will pay a daily fee of US\$150 to the selected International Referee for the competition and training period (total of 5 days, 27 to 31 may; US\$750 per referee, training and competition day).

- d) The Organizing Committee will pay a daily fee of US\$75 to the selected Panamerican Referee for the competition and training period (total of 5 days, 27 to 31 may; US\$375 per referee, training and competition day).
