1. Eligibility.

- ✓ Holder of a national certificate and/or Kukkiwon 1st Dan or higher.
- ✓ Recommendation by the national member association (MNA/Federation) to which the applicant belongs.
- ✓ Valid national referee certificate and/or PATU credential.
- ✓ 21 years or older (age is calculated based on the year the seminar is held).
 - ✓ Certificate of completion of the theoretical course.

The minimum participation fee for the seminar is “20” registrants.

The maximum registration limit will be based on the on-site capacity indicated by the host, up to 130 people.

2. Registration Fees

The price includes seminar fees, exam, participation certificate and certification credential.

Early Bird Registration (April 28th to May 2nd) \$100.00 USD.

Regular Registration (May 3rd to 20th) \$140.00 USD.

Payments can be made on-site, but on-site registration is not permitted. **Cash only will be accepted on-site.**

Refresher Seminar

Early Bird Registration (April 28th to May 2nd) \$50.00 USD. Regular

Registration (May 3rd to 20th) \$75.00USD.

Payment can be made on-site, but on-site registration will not be allowed.

Cash ONLY will be accepted on site.

3.Registration

Obtain the passing certificate, indicating that the theoretical foundations have been obtained. The exam will be held prior to the start of the in-person course.

4. Lodging

5. Ground Transportation

6. Method of payment

Payment will be made on-site in cash only in US dollars.

All participants must wear a dobok, tennis shoes and/or Taekwondo tennis shoes.

By registering for the Pan American Referee Seminar (PATU12), all participants accept the rules and conditions of participation established by the Organizing Committee. All participants participate at their own risk. The Organizer is not responsible for any loss or damage to persons or equipment under any circumstances.

9. Evaluation criteria

- ✓ Online Course: 50% of the certification. Applicants must complete all content available on the platform (poomsae and kyorugui) and complete the assessment, obtaining a minimum of 70 points in correct answers, to participate in the in-person seminar.
- ✓ In-Person Seminar: 50% of the certification. Applicants must register according to the guidelines described in this document, after passing the online course.

At the end of the in-person seminar, the candidate will be given a practical assessment. They must obtain an average of at least 70 points out of 100 to pass the practical exam.

Written notification of the exam results will be sent to the relevant National Association or Federation within one week of the end of the in-person course.

If you fail any of the sections, you will have one opportunity to retake it. In this case, you must submit the exam on the next available date on the schedule.

10. Certificate

Upon completing both evaluations (theoretical and practical) satisfactorily (70 points or more), the referee will have a credential with the number that identifies him in the Pan American Referee registry that will enable him to participate in the different events of the exclusive circuit for PAN AMERICANS.
