7. Competition rules:

The judging criteria will be those set forth in the World Taekwondo Federation's Poomsae Rules.

8. Referees:

The Pan American Union will appoint international referees for the red and black belt categories, and Pan American referees for the white, yellow, green, and blue belt categories, as well as the family categories.

9. Competition Uniforms:

All competitors must wear uniforms approved by the WT and PATU

Parents in the Family categories may wear a Poomsae competition uniform or a traditional Taekwondo dobok, and may also wear a white belt, unless they are or have been practitioners and wear a belt of a different color

10.Competition registrations:

Registration for the championship will take place on the UPTKD platform

13.Competition Method

- Cut-off system
- Pre-recorded
- It is recommended that videos be recorded at your dojangs, schools, or training facilities, preferably where there is sufficient space and a floor suitable for Taekwondo practice and competition

14.Competition Times

- Recognized Poomsae up to 90 seconds
- Freestyle Poomsae from 90 to 100 seconds

15. Compulsatory Poomsae for Black Belts

- 1ST PLACE GOLD MEDAL (Digital)
- 2ND PLACE – SILVER MEDAL (Digital)
- 3RD PLACE – BRONZE MEDAL (Digital)
- MVP POOMSAE (Male y Female – Recognized and Free Digital)
- BEST COACH (The one with more medals Digital)
- BEST POOMSAE REFEREE (Male and female Digital)
- DIGITAL TROPHY FOR TEAMS OR SCHOOLS (1st, 2nd y 3er place Digital).
- DIGITAL PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATE, FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS.

17.RANKING:

- Pan American Ranking P2 for ALL BLACK BELT CATEGORIES.

18.WILDCARDS:

ALL WINNERS OF 1ST, 2ND, AND 3RD PLACE IN THE BLACK BELT CATEGORIES WILL RECEIVE A WILDCARD FOR THE NEXT PAN AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP, BASED ON THEIR AGE GROUP
