6. ATHLETE ELEGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

In accordance with Article 4 (Qualification of Competitors) of the World Taekwondo Competition Rules, all participants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1: Athletes must hold a valid passport of the nationality they represent.

2: Athletes must hold a valid Taekwondo Black Belt (Dan or Poom).

3. Holder of a valid WT Global Athlete License.

4: All coaches must hold a valid WT Level I Coach Certificate. (Includes must hold a valid WT Global Athlete Licence)

7. COMPETITION CATEGORIES AND AGE DIVISIONS

Cadet: Athletes born between **2012 and 2014**.

Junior: Athletes born between **2009 and 2011**.

Senior: Athletes born in **2009 or earlier**.

8. RANKING:

World Taekwondo G1 World Ranking Points (Senior Kyorugi)

Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) P1 Ranking Points (Junior and Cadet Kyorugi)

9. COMPETITION RULES:

The latest edition of the World Taekwondo Competition Rules and Interpretation, as amended and effective in 2026, shall apply.

10. METHOD OF COMPETITION:

- **Single Elimination Tournament System**, Best of Three (3) Rounds.
- There is no limit on the number of entries in each division.
- Match duration may only be adjusted by the World Taekwondo Technical Delegate (WT TD).
- The **DAEDO Generation 3 (Gen 3) PSS** shall be used for the competition.

DRESS CODE:

The attire of all coaches shall comply with the World Taekwondo Dress Code.

During the Semifinal and Final rounds, coaches are required to wear a jacket (blazer) in accordance with the World Taekwondo Dress Code.

COMPETITION EQUIPMENT

The Organizing Committee (OC) will provide the electronic chest protectors (Hogu) and head protectors. Each athlete must bring his or her own electronic socks and electronic gloves for competition. All athletes are responsible for providing their own personal competition equipment.

All athletes must enter the Field of Play wearing World Taekwondo (WT) approved uniforms and competition equipment.

Groin protectors, forearm guards, and shin guards must be worn underneath the uniform. No item other than the head protector shall be worn on the head. Any religious apparel or articles must receive prior approval from World Taekwondo, be worn underneath the head protector and/or uniform, and must not cause injury to or interfere with the opponent.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS/DOBOK

All athletes must wear a white V-neck dobok approved by World Taekwondo (WT) and/or the Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU), in good condition.

No unauthorized logos or commercial markings shall be permitted. Only the athlete's country name and markings permitted under the World Taekwondo Uniform Rules may be displayed.

11. KYORUGI CONTEST TIME

- Competition System: Best of Three (3) Rounds.
- Senior: Two (2) minutes × Best of Three (3) Rounds, with one (1) minute rest between rounds.
- Junior: Two (2) minutes × Best of Three (3) Rounds, with one (1) minute rest between rounds.
- Cadet: One and a half (1.5) minutes × Best of Three (3) Rounds, with one (1) minute rest between rounds.

Best Male Kyorugi Referee / Best Female Kyorugi Referee

WILDCARDS:

A Wild Card will be awarded to all Gold Medalists (1st Place), which may be used for participation in the next Pan American Championship in the corresponding age division and weight category.

14. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Participants or their respective Member National Associations (MNAs) are responsible for all expenses related to round-trip airfare, accommodation, meals, and local transportation.

The Organizing Committee (OC) shall not be responsible for any incidents, accidents, losses, or other matters occurring outside the official hotel.

INSURANCES

The respective Member National Associations (MNAs) and/or participating teams shall ensure that all officials and participants are covered by adequate medical insurance.

15. GLOBAL LICENSE AND ONLINE REGISTRATION:

I. World Taekwondo Global License Registration

All athletes and team officials must hold a valid World Taekwondo Global Athlete License (GAL) or Global Official License (GOL) and be registered through the WT online registration system (Simply Compete).

II. Online Registration

Online registration is only available to holders of a valid WT Global License and is open to all eligible participants. National Team GMS Administrators will be notified by e-mail once online registration is available.

All athletes and team officials must be registered under their respective National Team using the official country name.

16. COACHES REGISTRATION:

I. World Taekwondo Global License Registration.

All athletes and team officials must hold a valid World Taekwondo Global Athlete License (GAL) or Global Official License (GOL).

II. World Taekwondo Online Registration (Simply Compete)

All registrations must be completed through the World Taekwondo online registration system (Simply Compete).

III. Coaches

All coaches must be at least 18 years of age.

All coaches must hold a valid World Taekwondo Level I Coach Certificate.

17. ENTRY FEE

- Registration fees must be paid at the Accreditation Desk located at the competition venue. Payment shall be made directly to the Organizing Committee (OC) in U.S. Dollars (USD) only.
- Registration fees are non-refundable.
- Athletes and coaches must provide proof of payment in order to complete accreditation and be eligible to participate.
- The Registration and Accreditation Desk will be located in the Multi-Purpose Room of Las Delicias Coliseum and will operate on the dates and during the hours specified in the Event Schedule.
- On-site registration will not be accepted. All registrations must be completed within the registration period specified below through the World Taekwondo GMS platform (Simply Compete).

18. TECHNICAL MEETING

The Head of Team Meeting shall be held one (1) day prior to the start of the competition. Please refer to the General Schedule for further details.

Should there be any changes to the scheduled date, time, or venue, the updated information will be communicated at least 24 hours in advance.

19. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

The Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) shall appoint the International Referees, including the PATU Referee Chairman.

The appointed International Referees officiating at the WT Colombia Open G1 – Sincelejo, Sucre, Colombia 2026 shall be subject to the following conditions:

- International Referees are responsible for their own round-trip airfare.
- The Organizing Committee (OC) will provide up to five (5) nights of hotel accommodation.
 - Check-in: Monday, August 3, 2026, from 13:00h.
 - Check-out: Saturday, August 8, 2026, before 11:00h.
- The Organizing Committee (OC) will pay a daily honorarium of USD 150 to the selected International Referees for each competition day and one (1) training day.
- The Organizing Committee (OC) will provide breakfast, lunch, and dinner from Tuesday, August 4, through Friday, August 7, 2026.

19.1 TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD (CSB)

World Taekwondo (WT) shall appoint one (1) Technical Delegate, and the Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) shall appoint up to three (3) members to serve on the Competition Supervisory Board (CSB).

INDEMNITIES

- i. Each participant must be covered by valid medical and travel insurance.
- ii. Participants who do not have adequate insurance coverage shall not be permitted to participate in the competition.
- iii. The Organizing Committee (OC) will obtain Public Liability Insurance for the event.
- iv. All participants must sign the Waiver of Liability upon registration.

20. ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION

Official Hotel: To be confirmed.

Detailed accommodation information, including hotel reservations and related arrangements, will be provided in a separate document available through **Simply Compete**.

21. VISA INFORMATION

Visa invitation letters will be issued by the Organizing Committee (OC).

The deadline to request a visa invitation letter is Friday, July 24, 2026, at 20:00 (local time). No visa invitation letters will be issued after this deadline.

To request a visa invitation letter, please send an e-mail to tkd_colombia@hotmail.com with the following documents:

- A copy of your passport, valid for at least six (6) months from the start of the competition; and
- Proof of registration.

22. MEDICAL SERVICES

The Organizing Committee (OC) will provide emergency medical services for participants who sustain an injury during the competition.

Participants shall be responsible for all medical expenses arising from the treatment of injuries and/or hospitalization.

The Organizing Committee (OC) strongly recommends that all participants have valid medical insurance and carry all necessary insurance documents to ensure access to medical treatment and/or hospitalization, if required.
